

Resolution in Support of Financial Transparency and the Protection of Personal Information

Whereas, the Davis County Republican Party (DCRP) was required to provide its own 2018 Caucus Night signs,

Whereas, all DCRP County Chairs and Vice-Chairs received the attached email (labeled KMV Caucus Night Signs Email),

Whereas, DCRP leadership accepted the deal offered by Keep My Voice,

Whereas, some of the information requested and included in the deal with Keep My Voice is not required to be published by DCRP governing documents,

Whereas, Caucus Night Attendees have not consented to the sale of their personal information;

Resolved, that the DCRP Officers and Executive Committee disclose via email to all Caucus Night attendees and on the DCRP website what information was given to Keep My Voice in exchange for Caucus Night signs,

Resolved, that the Davis County Republican Party Officers and Executive Committee disclose the total amount of donations given to Keep My Voice by the Davis County Republican Party, including monetary donations, sponsorships, and gifts.

KMV CAUCUS NIGHT SIGNS EMAIL

On Monday, February 12, 2018 5:43 PM, Patti Bateman [REDACTED] wrote:

This is Patti from Keep My Voice. I'm forwarding this letter to you from Dave Bateman. " It's my understanding that the State Party is requiring the Counties to fund their own Caucus reminder yard signs this year. **Keep My Voice would love to donate Caucus signs to you to meet this requirement.** As you know we are very eager to support the Caucus system and make Caucus Night 2018 the best yet!

In return, we ask for your help gathering the following pieces of data to promote the Caucus-Convention System:

1. Contact info for each of your State and County delegates.
2. The locations of your Caucus Meetings this year, per precinct.
3. The contact info for any leg chairs or other leg leaders.
4. If you happen to have old lists of delegates from any years between 2000 and 2018, that would be super helpful as well. Delegates are much more likely to volunteer to help us preserve the Caucus System, and we are in desperate need of volunteers.
5. Our goal is to have a volunteer assigned to every precinct in the State. That's a huge task. Could you possibly help us find volunteers in each precinct?

If we have a deal, let me know where we can send the signs once printed. We will put a small "Save the Caucus System" phrase at the bottom of the signs, leaving most of the sign to notify people of the location of their Caucus meetings.

You probably know that the State Central Committee passed a resolution to play a video and read a statement that promotes the Caucus-Convention System on Caucus night. After the video and statement, the Keep My Voice initiative is supposed to be passed around for all attendees to sign, if they choose. The Keep My Voice ballot initiative fights Count My Vote head on, repeals the corrupt SB54, and fully restores the Caucus-Convention System. We hope you will fight with us on this ever important initiative."
