 - OAI: Don: Find out who the Young Republicans of Davis County is
- Special Guest Brian McKenzie-(15 Minutes)
 - Election integrity: Transparency-Important to make sure everyone knows how to get involved. Online many points of information. He reaches out to candidates to know that they can have poll watchers. Important to answer constituents questions and concerns. Voter rolls analysis and accuracy. Review of voting systems. Robust audits of votes, and petitions. Next Friday, post election audit: cast vote record must match summary report. Board of commission member always invited to audits.
 - Signatures: Candidates could not access all the info that they want to. Errors have been made. Candidates did their part. Election officers did their part. Error rate between 4 and 1%.
 - Changes: Audit prior to certification
 - Candidates access to petitions
 - Watchers established
 - Log in to see which petition you have signed.

SB 164

Ryan Miggins: Signature threshold met. When the threshold met, verification stopped.
Signature verification is subjective.

Norm Parker: Are all of the county clerks involved in the signature count?

No, all county clerks are not involved. Under authority of Lieutenant Governor.
Kenna Arcury: How do you verify signatures?

There are up to 5 comparison points per signature.

Bruce Finch: Has the person requesting access to the packets received access yet?

Davis county does not have them. Lieutenant Governor has them.

Davis County issues have all been resolved.

Terry Finch: When would be a good time to pull data for caucus?

We update voter registrations daily. **Early January**

Don Guymon: Are there boundary adjustments?

Yes, by the end of December. Redistricting may affect County boundaries with "Map C" (a very small part).
